NATIONAL LOTTERY LICENCE

APPOINTMENT OF PREFERRED AND RESERVE BIDDERS

The Gaming Board of Tanzania is a regulatory body, established by the Gaming Act, 2003 (Act No. 4/2003) to oversee, monitor and regulate the conduct of gaming activities in Tanzania. The Board is currently in the process of appointing a suitable company and grant a licence to conduct national lottery operations in Tanzania. The license lasts for five years.

The Board has completed evaluation of applications for the national lottery licence. Consequently, on 18th February 2010 the Board appointed a Preferred Bidder and two Reserve Bidders for the National Lottery Licence. The Preferred Bidder is **Winlot Tanzania Limited** and the Reserve Bidders are:

- First Reserve Bidder is **Tanzania Lottery Exchange**; and
- Second Reserve Bidder is **Entertainment Africa**
